



Guidelines for Parents

At KC Talent we provide professional management for our young actors. We are very selective when signing on young talent and invite parents to review our guidelines before submitting for representation.

First and foremost, parents must understand what is required of them. If you decide to submit your child for representation you must also agree to be available at all times, often on very short notice. This industry doesn't operate on school hours. It is a business, and for child actors it all depends on guardianship. Casting agents may place availability over talent so if you meet the criteria you are further ahead.
